



# Sculpture Competition



**Sunday, 11<sup>th</sup> August 2019**  
**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- The competition is open to anyone (professional, amateur or emerging artist).
- Maximum 2 entries per person.
- Entries open 1<sup>st</sup> July 2019. Entry forms are available for download from the webpage or at the Loxton Library & Visitor Information Centre and must include an Artist Statement.
- There is a non-refundable entry fee of **\$10** per entry.
- Entry forms must be completed in full and lodged **with entry fee and Artists Statement**, either at the Loxton Library & Visitor Information Centre, 25A East Terrace, Loxton or via email to [admin@loxtonchamber.com.au](mailto:admin@loxtonchamber.com.au) by **5pm Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2019**.
- Entries will be accepted in two categories; Youth (10 yrs to 17 yrs) or Open (18 yrs +).
- Categories will be judged separately and a People's Choice prize awarded for both category.
- Cash Prizes will be: Open (Winner) \$1,000, Open (Merit) \$600, Open People's Choice \$500, Youth (Winner) \$400, Youth (Merit) \$300, Youth People's Choice \$200. The judges' decision is final.
- A minimum of 5 entries per category must be received for sculptures to be judged and prizes awarded.
- All sculptures must be composed of predominately discarded, salvaged, reused or recycled materials **not previously entered in this competition**.
- Sculpture will be judged on creativity, innovation, standard of production and technical expertise.
- Materials for sticking, fixing, joining, gluing etc. may be new, but take the challenge to recycle, reclaim, borrow etc. where possible.
- Sculpture must be no larger than 2m (length) x 2m (width) x 2m (height). Actual size to be indicated on Entry Form.
- Sculpture to be freestanding or self-supporting. Indicate preference of tabletop or floor\* on entry form to assist with allocation of display space. *\*Protection must be used to safeguard tiles.*
- If it is essential for your sculpture to be hung, it is the responsibility of the artist to provide appropriate free standing hanging devices etc.
- All decisions pertaining to the display of the sculptures is at the discretion of the competition organiser.
- In the event that a sculpture is deemed unsuitable or does not meet the competition criteria, the competition organiser reserves the right to withdraw it from the competition.
- Sculptures are entered and exhibited at the artists own risk. The competition organiser accepts no responsibility/liability for any damage incurred to the sculpture during the exhibition. It is the artists responsibility to arrange insurance protection for the sculpture if deemed necessary.
- **All sculptures are required to be displayed for judging at Riverland Motor Group, 1 East Terrace on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2019 between 10am and 3pm.** Winners will be announced at 1.30pm.
- Sculptures can be delivered and set up at Riverland Ford, 1 East Terrace on either Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2019 from 3pm - 5pm, or Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2019 from 9am - 10am.
- Sculptures are to be collected on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> August 2019 between 3pm - 4pm. Sculptures not collected by 4pm will be held at the Loxton Library & Visitor Information Centre for a maximum of 2 days. After this time the sculpture will be disposed of.
- Artists agree to their names and images of their entries being used for promotional purposes.
